Official Rules

- 1. Sponsorship and Eligibility.** This contest is sponsored by Farm Credit Mid-America, 12501 Lakefront Place, Louisville, Kentucky 40299. There is no purchase necessary to enter or win. The Forward Thinker Award is designed to recognize innovative thinkers among our Growing Forward[®] program. Eligibility is based on the following criteria:
 - a. An applicant can be an individual or entity.
 - b. Must have attended at least one of the following: a Know to Grow[®] conference or Know to Thrive (level 2 conference), a Mastering Your Capital workshop a FCMA sponsored community event, or recommended by an FCMA employee.
 - c. Applicant must not be a Farm Credit Mid-America employee or immediately related to one.
 - d. Applicant must not be a part of the Farm Credit Mid-America Board of Directors or Nominating Committee.
 - e. Applicant must not be a local elected official.
 - f. Applicant must be willing to do an in-person or virtual interview and/or presentation.
 - g. Applicant must complete application packet.
 - h. Applicant must provide a sponsor letter/letter of support along with application.
 - i. Applicant must serve constituents based within the Farm Credit Mid-America operational geography.

This contest is open to legal residents of the United States who are eighteen (18) years or older at the time of entry; however, the contest is void where otherwise prohibited or restricted by law. Employees of Farm Credit Mid-America, its affiliates, licensees, franchisees, advertising and promotional agencies and the immediate family members of each are not eligible. No purchase necessary to enter or win the contest.

In addition, the award recipient will be provided an opportunity to work with the Farm Credit Mid-America Corporate Communications Team to develop featured media, if desired.
